O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed July 2, 2019, Mojo Mobility, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeks authority as a contract carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van and sedan in open class service between points in Thurston, Dakota, Cuming, Burt, Dodge, Washington, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, Cass, Otoe, Butler, Colfax, Lancaster and Seward counties over irregular routes. The transportation will be provided pursuant to contracts with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services ("NDHHS"), a Medicaid-managed care organization under contract with NDHHS, or another agent working on behalf of NDHHS. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 8, 2019. No protests were filed. The application was then processed pursuant to Rule 002.10B of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service and conform to the provisions of NEB. REV. STAT. §§ 75-301 to 75-322 (Cum. Supp. 2016) and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
2. Upon compliance with NEB. REV. STAT. §§ 75-305 (fees) and 75-307 (insurance) (Cum. Supp. 2016), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, a Permit of Authority should be issued as proposed:

CONTRACT: Transportation of passengers by van and sedan in open class service between points in Thurston, Dakota, Cuming, Burt, Dodge, Washington, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, Cass, Otoe, Butler, Colfax, Lancaster and Seward counties over irregular routes pursuant to contracts with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services ("NDHHS"), a Medicaid-managed care organization under contract with NDHHS, or another agent working on behalf of NDHHS.

3. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1966 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Permit of Authority shall be issued to Mojo Mobility, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, in Application No. B-1966, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not be issued the Permit of Authority authorized by the Commission unless and until Applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time

from the effective date of this Order, with NEB. REV. STAT. §§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Cum. Supp. 2016), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to Applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not conduct operations until a Permit of Authority is issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
