BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 13, 2019, Davis Entertainment LLC d/b/a Ollie the Trolley ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application seeking authority to extend its common carrier authority to allow for the use of vans in its open class service between points in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, and Washington counties, and between said counties, over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and Applicant is not seeking HHS Designation. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 17, 2019.

Timely protests were filed by WHC NE, LLC d/b/a zTrip; WHC NE, LLC, d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab; WHC NE, LLC, d/b/a Checker Cab Company; WHC NE, LLC, d/b/a Yellow Cab Company; WHC NE, LLC, d/b/a Safeway Cabs (collectively, "zTrip"); Camelot Transportation, Inc., and Triumph Transportation, Inc. (together with zTrip, "Protestants"). Protests were granted on July 30, 2019.

On August 28, 2019, a telephonic planning conference was held to discuss a procedural schedule and hearing dates. Jamie Reyes and Dillon Keiffer-Johnson represented the Commission, and the following persons participated by telephone: Jack Shultz on behalf of Applicant, and Jaydon Pence on behalf of Protestants.

Several procedural dates were decided during the planning conference. Therefore, this order serves to memorialize those decisions and provide a timeline for proceeding in this docket. I find that the following schedule should be adopted:
