O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

By application filed March 21, 2018, Papio Transport Service, Inc., ("Papio" or "Applicant"), Papillion, seeks approval of the consolidation or merger of the properties and certificates of public convenience and necessity of Papio and Trendy Transports ("Trendy"), Omaha, Certificate B-1123, resulting in the merger of Trendy into and with Papio. In its Application, Applicant requested that the Commission grant temporary approval to the Applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of the temporary authority request was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 19, 2019, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission. There were no protests to the temporary operating request.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to NEB. REV. STAT. § 75-319.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Papio Transport Service, Inc., be, and is hereby, granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-311 and to the rules and regulations of the

Commission; such grant of temporary authority shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
