BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 4, 2018, D&Z Transportation, LLC ("Applicant"), Bellevue, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce to transport passengers in open class by van in between points in Douglas and Sarpy counties, and points between said counties, over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 18, 2018. Timely protests were filed by Golden Plains Services Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation, Camelot Transportation, and Triumph Transportation. Protests were granted on May 8, 2019.

On May 8, 2019, the Hearing Officer entered an Order scheduling a planning conference in order to determine a procedural schedule and set a hearing date. It was later determined that the planning conference needed to be rescheduled. Commission staff spoke with Applicant, who indicated that he no longer wanted to pursue the application. Applicant was asked to submit a written withdrawal request by September 3, 2019. No request was filed. On September 17, 2019, the Commission entered an Order of Pending Dismissal, requiring Applicant to contact the Commission about its application no later than October 1, 2019. To date, Applicant has not submitted a withdrawal request or taken any further action on the application.
