O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed October 15, 2019, Yellow Cab of Beatrice, Inc. ("Applicant"), Beatrice, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Leisure Taxi, LLC, Lincoln, in Certificate B-1830. The authority to be acquired is described in the attached Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

In its application, Applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 18, 2019, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission. No protests to the temporary operating authority request were filed.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificates sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-319.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Yellow Cab Beatrice, Beatrice, should be, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-311 and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.

CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above- named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., Sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 2014), and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED, that pursuant to the Commission's Order the said carrier be, and it is hereby, issued this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to the said carrier.

AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED, that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce shall be as specified below:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: The transportation of passengers by taxicab between points in Lancaster County, and points within said county, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: Transportation is to originate in Lancaster County. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of passengers by taxicab between points in Lancaster County, and points within said county, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: Transportation services to points in Nebraska shall originate in Lancaster County, and transportation from points in Nebraska, except Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, and Washington counties, shall terminate in Lancaster County. Service shall not originate in Cass, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, and Washington County. For services with stops in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, and Washington counties, transportation shall originate in Lancaster County, and may include round trips originating in Lancaster County, including trips for which the return leg is provided on a later date than the outbound leg, provided the

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return trip terminate in Lancaster County. The transportation of passengers from Eppley Airfield in Omaha, even as a return leg, is not authorized. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.
