BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 20, 2017, an application was filed by Medivac Corp d/b/a Metro Medical Transportation ("Applicant"), Harlan, Iowa, seeking to acquire, through transfer, the operating rights granted to David F. Miller d/b/a Metro Medical Transportation, Inc. ("Metro"), Omaha, in Certificate B-1456. On November 13, 2019, the Commission entered an Order of Pending Dismissal requiring Applicant to contact the Commission no later than November 22, 2019, or steps would be taken to dismiss the application. To date, Applicant has not contacted the Commission or taken steps to complete its application.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Application No. B-1962 should be dismissed.
