BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On September 27, 2019, a Hearing Officer Order was entered adopting a procedural schedule and setting the above-captioned matter for hearing on December 11, 2019.

Timely protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; and WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip (together, "Protestants"). Protests were granted September 12, 2019.

On or around December 4, 2019, Protestants' attorney notified the Commission that the parties had potentially reached settlement of the issues and the December 11, 2019 hearing was unnecessary. On December 11, 2019, Protestants filed a Motion to Continue the hearing to give the parties additional time to finalize settlement. No objections were received.

Based on the above, I find that Protestants' Motion to Continue the hearing scheduled for December 11, 2019, should be granted. Hearing on this matter will be rescheduled to a date to be later determined.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that Protestants' Motion to Continue the Hearing be, and is hereby, granted.
