BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On August 13, 2019, Price's Party Patrol, LLC, ("Applicant"), Lexington, filed an application seeking to extend its authority as a common carrier to transport passengers between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS Designation is no. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 23, 2019.

On September 23, 2019, a timely protest was filed by VIP Limousine, LLC. On November 13, 2019, I entered an order granting the protest.

A hearing was scheduled for January 27, 2020. Prior to the hearing, the Commission was informed that the parties had reached a proposed settlement and that a hearing was not necessary. On January 10, 2020, the Protestant filed a Motion to withdraw their protests.

Based on the above, I find that the protest of VIP Limousine, LLC, should be withdrawn.
