By application filed January 21, 2020, Western Limousine, LLC, ("Applicant"), Imperial, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No. B-1820 on December 11, 2012. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by limousine in a 500 mile radius of Imperial, Nebraska, over irregular routes with the following restrictions: no trips will originate east of Grand Island, the transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not allowed and HHS Designation is no. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 29, 2020. No protests were filed; therefore, this application shall be processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Western Limousine Service, LLC, in Docket No. B-1820 should be cancelled.
