The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus and van in special party and charter between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews is not allowed and HHS Designation is no. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 6, 2020. No protests were filed.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Meltech, Lincoln, in Docket No. B-1943 should be cancelled.
