BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 10, 2018, NOVA Medical Trans, LLC ("Applicant"), Lincoln, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier to transport passengers in open class by van in between points in Douglas and Lancaster counties, and points between said counties, over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 16, 2018.

On October 26, 2018, Camelot Transportation and Triumph Transportation filed their protests. On November 13, 2018, Golden Plains Services Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation filed a protest. Protests were granted by Hearing Officer Order on April 3, 2019.

On April 29, 2019 an Order was entered adopting the procedural schedule and scheduling a hearing for July 24, 2019. On July 5, 2019, Applicant informed the Commission that Applicant's counsel had withdrawn. A conference call was held on July 10, 2019, wherein Applicant requested the hearing set for July 24, 2019, be continued to allow for time to retain counsel. There were no objections to Applicant's request. Commission staff attempted to contact Applicant regarding the Application and received no response.

On February 18, 2020, Applicant was sent a letter giving Applicant until February 28, 2020, to contact the Commission regarding Applicant's intent to proceed with their application.

To date, Applicant has failed to contact the Commission and indicate how they wish to proceed with their application.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that a deadline for action to be taken by Applicant in this docket should be set. If the Commission does not receive any communication or filing from Applicant by April 17, 2020, the Commission will dismiss the application for failure to take timely action.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a deadline for communication with the Commission by NOVA Medical Trans, LLC, Lincoln, in Application No. B-1982, be and is hereby, set for April 17, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if NOVA Medical Trans, LLC fails to take action by April 17, 2020 in Application No. B-1982, the Commission will exercise its authority to enter an order dismissing the application.
