## O P I N I O N S   A N D   F I N D I N G S

By application filed on April 3, 2020, Christopher M. Beerbohm ("Applicant"), Fremont, Nebraska, requests a suspension of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Docket No. B-1936 until June 1, 2020. Applicant is authorized to provide transportation by bus in special party and charter service in all points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

On March 31, 2020, the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services issued Directed Health Measure Order 2020-007 in order to reduce morbidity and mortality; minimize disease transmission; protect health care personnel and preserve health care system functionality due to the COVID-19 global pandemic. Pursuant to the Directed Health Measure, gatherings of ten (10) or more patrons are prohibited except for explicitly enumerated gatherings. Applicant's operations are not included as an exception. As a result, Applicant is no longer in a position to provide its usual special party and charter bus services due to the Directed Health Measure and requests that its Certificate be suspended.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Docket No. B-1936 should be suspended until June 1, 2020.

## O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request of Christopher M. Beerbohm, Fremont, Nebraska, to suspend the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Docket No. B-1936 be, and it is hereby, granted, and Certificate B-1936 is suspended until June 1, 2020.
