BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 10, 2020, Jamie Reyes, Director of the Motor Transportation Department ("Complainant") filed a complaint against the above-captioned Respondents alleging violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305 (Reissue 2018). Complainant alleges that Respondents failed to timely file annual fees as required by § 75-305 by March 1, 2020. Complainant seeks an order revoking Respondents' Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity and to require Respondents to cease and desist from offering services

as motor carriers pursuant to §75-133, and/or to assess any such fines authorized by law for failure to remit annual fees in compliance with § 75-305.

Subsequent to the Complaint, the following Respondents remitted the required annual fees to the Commission:

Big A Holdings, LLC d/b/a OMALiNK
Nightlife Limousine, LLC

These Respondents have complied with § 75-305 by making the proper payments. As this was the first late renewal payment for these Respondents, each Respondent applied for and was granted a waiver of administrative fines. As such, staff recommends that the above-named Respondents should be dismissed from the Complaint. Respondents are on notice that failure to remit future annual fee payments in a timely manner could result in administrative fines and costs.

Additionally, the Commission received the renewal payment from the following Respondent:

Ronald D. Allgood d/b/a Tree City Cab Company

Tree City was granted a waiver for its late renewal payment last year and was put on notice that it would not be eligible for a waiver in any subsequent year for failure to remit future annual fee payments in a timely manner.¹ The Commission has received Tree City's administrative fine payment made in accordance with the Department's fee schedule. As such, staff recommends that Tree City be dismissed from the Complaint. Tree City is put on further notice that failure to remit future annual fee payments in a timely manner could result in administrative fines and costs as well as other Commission action.

Finally, the following Respondent has notified Commission staff that they are no longer in business:

The Wine Bus, LLC

This Respondent has filed the appropriate paperwork to cancel their Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. Such cancellation will be managed in a separate docket. Therefore, Staff recommends dismissing The Wine Bus, LLC from the Complaint.

Based on the above, the Commission finds Ronald D. Allgood d/b/a Tree City Cab Company; Big A Holdings, LLC d/b/a OMALiNK; Nightlife Limousine, LLC; and The Wine Bus, LLC, should be dismissed from the Complaint.





O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Ronald D. Allgood d/b/a Tree City Cab Company; Big A Holdings, LLC d/b/a OMALiNK; Nightlife Limousine, LLC; and The Wine Bus, LLC be, and are hereby, dismissed from the Complaint.
