BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 10, 2020, Jamie Reyes, Director of the Motor Transportation Department ("Complainant") filed a complaint

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against the above-captioned Respondents alleging violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305 (Reissue 2018). Complainant alleges that Respondents failed to timely file annual fees as required by § 75-305 by March 1, 2020. Complainant seeks an order revoking Respondents' Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity and to require Respondents to cease and desist from offering services as motor carriers pursuant to §75-133, and/or to assess any such fines authorized by law for failure to remit annual fees in compliance with § 75-305.

Subsequent to the Complaint, Department staff have acquired information regarding certain Respondents discussed below.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

First, a review of annual renewal documents determined that the following Respondent was mistakenly named as a Respondent to the Complaint:

Omaha Omaha Handicap Transportation Services

The Department confirmed that Omaha Omaha has completed all requirements for this year's annual renewal, and should therefore be dismissed from the Complaint.

In addition, the following Respondent has completed all annual renewal requirements:

Daniel's Moving & Storage of Omaha, LLC

Daniel's remitted the required annual renewal fees to the Commission prior to the March 1, 2020, delinquency deadline; but failed to provide the Commission with the remaining vehicle information that is required as part of the annual renewal. The Commission has since received all required documentation from Daniel's and should therefore be dismissed from the complaint.

The above-mentioned carriers are not subject to any administrative fines and remain eligible to receive a one-time waiver of administrative fines if named a Respondent in a future complaint.

Based on the above, the Commission finds Daniel's Moving & Storage of Omaha, LLC and Omaha Omaha Handicap Transportation Services should be dismissed from the Complaint.

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O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Daniel's Moving & Storage of Omaha, LLC and Omaha Omaha Handicap Transportation Services be, and are hereby, dismissed from the Complaint.
