BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 13, 2020, Fremont Cab Service, LLC ("Applicant"), Fremont, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend its rates as follows:

Applicant requested that the application be considered on an emergency basis.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1704. The Certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxicab within Fremont and points in the immediate area. HHS Designation is yes.

In support of its application, Applicant states that its operating costs have dramatically increased. Applicant cites

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its insurance and maintenance as two specific costs that have risen to the point that Applicant believes a rate increase is necessary. Applicant previously amended its rates in 2009.

Applicant is seeking to increase its initial drop charge from \$2.50 to \$4.00 (a 60% increase) and to increase its mileage charges from \$0.25 every $1/8^{\text{th}}$ of a mile to \$0.25 every $1/10^{\text{th}}$ of a mile (a 25% increase). Applicant also requests an increase to its fuel surcharge to be added to the proposed increased base fare per trip. There are no proposed changes to wait time, additional passenger charge, or the refusal of service charge.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists in order to grant said application on an emergency basis. After reviewing the application as set forth, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the proposed rate increases cannot be approved without additional information. In its June 30, 2009 order granting Applicant's last rate increase (also on an emergency basis), the Commission advised Applicant to make more timely applications to ensure smaller rate increases for the general public. 1 Although Applicant submitted some information regarding increased costs with its application, it has been ten years since Applicant's last rate adjustment and the increase it is requesting is substantial enough to warrant additional information before the entry of a final order.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be denied on an emergency basis. The Commission further finds that the Application should be processed pursuant to Commission rules regarding rate applications.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application TR-217 be, and is hereby, denied on
