## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On May 21, 2019, Richwood Transport of Nebraska, LLC ("Applicant"), Middleton, Wisconsin, filed an application seeking authority as a contract carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van in open class service between points in Douglas, Lancaster, Sarpy, Hall, Platte, Gage, Dodge, Madison, Lincoln, and Scotts Bluff counties over irregular routes pursuant to a contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, a Medicaid-managed care organization under contract with NDHHS, or another agent working on behalf of NDHHS. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the Application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 1, 2019.

Timely protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc. ("Camelot"); Triumph Transportation, Inc.,("Triumph"); Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab("Action Cab"); WHC NE, LLC d/b/a zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; and WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip ("zTrip")(together, "Protestants"). Protests were granted September 12, 2019.

On April 23, 2020, a planning conference was held to discuss a procedural schedule and set a hearing date. Ms. Jamie Reyes, Mr. Dillon Keiffer-Johnson, and Commissioner Tim Schram appeared for the Commission.
