BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On October 4, 2019, LaToya Prince Ventures, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application seeking authority as a contract carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to a contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 19, 2020.

On April 17, 2020, protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; and WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip (collectively "Protestants"). All protests were timely filed.

After due consideration, I find that the protests filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; WHC

NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; and WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip should be granted.
