## O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

By application filed April 14, 2020, Bar Crawler Party Bus ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No. B-1950 on July 11, 2017. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter service within all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews is not allowed and HHS Designation is no. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 23, 2020. No protests were filed.

According to the Application, Applicant states that he had decided to no longer operate due to the COVID-19 pandemic and is converting his bus into a camper. As Applicant will no longer provide transportation for hire, a certificate is not necessary.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Bar Crawler Party Bus, Omaha, in Docket No. B-1950 should be cancelled.

## O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of Bar Crawler Party Bus, Omaha, be, and is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Docket No. B-1950 is hereby cancelled.
