O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed April 27, 2020, Nightlife Party Bus ("Applicant"), Beatrice, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No. B-1934 on August 2, 2016. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews is not allowed and HHS Designation is no. The carrier transported passengers in special party and charter service pursuant to its authority. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 29, 2020. No protests were filed.

According to the Application, Applicant states that she no longer operates vehicles under this authority. As Applicant will no longer provide transportation for hire, a certificate is not necessary.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Nightlife Party Bus, Beatrice, in Docket No. B-1934 should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of Nightlife Party Bus, Beatrice, be, and is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Docket No. B-1934 is hereby cancelled.
