O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), on its own motion, is seeking revocation of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to Roadrunner Bus, LLC, Weston, in Docket No. B-1920.

The Commission granted Roadrunner Bus authority to operate and provide transportation of passengers by bus between all points in the State of Nebraska. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized and the HHS designation is no. Roadrunner Bus was originally granted its authority on December 15, 2015.

Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305(1) requires all regulated motor carriers to pay an annual fee not exceeding eighty dollars (\$80) for each motor vehicle operated. Annual fees are due and payable to the Commission on or before January 1 and are delinquent March 1.¹

Rapid Shuttle Service failed to pay its annual renewal fee as required by § 75-305(1) and was therefore named a Respondent in a Department Complaint opened March 5, 2020.² Hearing on the

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Complaint was held on May 5, 2020. No representative of Rapid Shuttle Service appeared at the hearing.

A company representative signed for the certified letter containing notice of the Complaint against Roadrunner Bus and the March 13, 2020 show cause hearing. No action was taken by any representative for Rapid Shuttle Serviced to resolve the complaint or pay the annual fee. Department staff recommended at the hearing that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity held by Roadrunner Bus be revoked and the carrier be assessed a civil penalty of three-thousand, eight-hundred dollars (\$3,800). The Commission entered an order on June 30, 2020 sustaining the Complaint against Roadrunner Bus and adopting Department recommendations.³ To date, there has been no response to Commission communications or Orders.

Based on the above, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the authority granted to Roadrunner Bus, LLC, Weston, in Docket No. B-1920 should be revoked for failure to comply with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305(1). All PSC plates assigned to Roadrunner Bus must be returned to the Commission within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order. Moreover, the civil penalty of three-thousand, eight-hundred dollars, was assessed to Roadrunner Bus, LLC in the Commission's June 30, 2020 Order. No subsequent applications for authority will be granted until the above-mentioned civil penalty is satisfied.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Roadrunner Bus, LLC, Weston, in Docket No. B-1920 be, and is hereby, revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all vehicle plates assigned by the Commission must be returned to the Commission within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order.
