BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On April 6, 2020, Prosperity Properties, Inc., d/b/a Omaha Supportive Living ("Applicant") Omaha, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by sedan and van between points in Douglas County over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 7, 2020.

On May 8, 2020, protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; and WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip. All protests were timely filed.

After due consideration, I find that the protests filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; and WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip should be granted.


