BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On October 4, 2019, LaToya Prince Ventures, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application seeking authority as a contract carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to a contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 19, 2020.

Timely protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, INC.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip; and Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab (together, "Protestants").

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On June 16, 2020, a telephonic planning conference was held to discuss the procedural schedule and hearing date. Written discovery responses were due by July 24, 2020. On August 20, 2020, the Protestants filed a motion to compel discovery and continue the hearing alleging no responses to written discovery requests had been received from Applicant. Hearing was scheduled for August 26, 2020. On August 25, 2020, I entered an order to continue the hearing to a date to be determined.

Based on the above, I find that a telephonic hearing is necessary to decide what, if any, discovery must be submitted and to determine a new procedural schedule and hearing date. Telephonic hearing on this matter shall be set for **Wednesday, September 9, 2020, at 10:00 a.m.** Parties should use the following call bridge number **(888) 820-1398**, and attendee code **5582059#**.
