## OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On May 4, 2020, Careem Transportation, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application to suspend its operations until April 20, 2021. Applicant requested suspension due to difficulties in acquiring insurance in the time prior to and during the Directed Health Measures imposed this spring by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. In addition, Applicant sought time to pay its annual fee in compliance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305.¹ Applicant's request was granted by Commission Order entered July 14, 2020.² In its Order, the Commission stated that Careem would need to come into compliance with all Commission requirements, including insurance and fees, prior to reinstatement of its authority.³

Applicant contacted Commission staff to express its interest in reinstating its authority prior to the approved end date. As of November 9, 2020, Applicant has complied with the provisions of

Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-305 (Fees), 75-307 (Insurance) and with the Rules and Regulations of the Commission. Applicant was dismissed from the show cause proceeding and therefore has no further compliance obligation. The Commission reminds Applicant to be mindful of future compliance deadlines or possibly face adverse Commission action.

Upon due consideration, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the suspension should be dismissed and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1948 should be reinstated.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the suspension of Careem Transportation, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, dismissed, and that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1948 be, and it is hereby, reinstated.
