O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On June 30, 2020, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered an Order to dismiss in part and sustain in part the above-captioned complaint. In its Order, the Commission levied an administrative penalty against Bus at the Yard d/b/a Luxury Limousine ("Respondent"), Lincoln, in the amount of three-

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thousand eight-hundred dollars (\$3,800) and ordered to cease and desist all services.¹

Respondent paid the annual renewal fees for its vehicles on May 5, 2020 and paid the administrative fine in full on October 2, 2020. Respondent and Complainant also entered into a stipulation on November 5, 2020, agreeing to Respondent's dismissal from the complaint.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission finds that the stipulation between Bus at the Yard d/b/a Luxury Limousine and the Motor Transportation Department should be accepted and Bus at the Yard d/b/a Luxury Limousine should be dismissed from the complaint. The Commission also finds that the cease and desist should be removed and Respondent may resume providing services. Respondent is on notice that failure to timely remit future annual renewal payments may result in further Commission action.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Bus at the Yard d/b/a Luxury Limousine be, and is hereby, dismissed from the Complaint.
