BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On October 1, 2020, I entered a Hearing Officer order granting LaToya Prince Ventures, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, by and through counsel, an extension of time to file its responses to discovery requests served on Applicant by Camelot Transportation, Inc.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip; and Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab (together, "Protestants"). Applicant was given until October 26, 2020 to send its responses to Protestants. Applicant's counsel withdrew from the matter on October 7, 2020.

On November 30, 2020, Applicant filed a written request to continue the procedural schedule until after the holidays due to illness. Protestants have indicated that there is no objection to the request for continuance.
