BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On September 18, 2020 Oceans Enterprise, LLC d/b/a Oceans Drive Transportation ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application seeking to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by removing the restriction on number of vehicles and operating radius within Cass, Douglas, Dodge, Washington, and Sarpy counties. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 22, 2020.

Timely protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc. ("Camelot") and Triumph Transportation, Inc. ("Triumph"). Protests were granted November 5, 2020.

On December 3, 2020, a planning conference was held to discuss a procedural schedule and set a hearing date. Ms. Jamie Reyes, Mr. Dillon Keiffer-Johnson, and Commissioner Mary Ridder appeared for the Commission. The following appeared via telephone: Ms. Nicole Jilek on behalf of the Applicant, and Mr. Andy Pollock on behalf the Protestants.

As a result of the planning conference, several issues were decided. Therefore, this Order serves to memorialize those decisions and provide a timeline for proceeding in this docket. I find that the following schedule should be adopted:

1/15/2021	All written discovery responses due.
1/29/2021	Final date for depositions.
2/10/2021	Final date to exchange witness and exhibit lists.
2/24/2021 at 10:00 a.m.	Hearing

Furthermore, hearing on this matter shall be set for **February 24, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska.
