By application filed on or around November 12, 2020, Myers Luxury Coaches, Inc. ("Applicant"), Stuart, Nebraska, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in docket No. B-1677 on October 12, 2006. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter service between points in Nebraska. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. Regular route service between Chadron and Norfolk is not authorized. Transportation of trips originating in Douglas, Lancaster, and Sarpy counties is not authorized. HHS designation is no. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on November 17, 2020. No protests were received. Therefore, this application was processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the request should be granted and the authority granted to Myers Luxury Coaches, Inc., Stuart, Nebraska, in Docket No. B-1677 should be cancelled.
