BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On August 28, 2020, Recommended Care Solutions, LLC, d/b/a MedCare Mobility ("Applicant") Omaha, filed an application seeking to extend its authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passenger by van in open class service between points in Butler, Cass, Colfax, and Lancaster counties, and between said counties and existing counties, over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 30, 2020.

On October 30, 2020, protests were timely filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc., and Triumph Transportation, Inc.

After due consideration, I find that the protest filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc., and Triumph Transportation, Inc., should be granted.
