BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On August 28, 2020, Recommended Care Solutions, LLC, d/b/a MedCare Mobility ("Applicant") Omaha, filed an application seeking to extend its authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passenger by van in open class service between points in Butler, Cass, Colfax, and Lancaster counties, and between said counties over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 30, 2020.

Timely protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc. and Triumph Transportation. Protests were granted on January 14, 2021.

A hearing was scheduled for April 13, 2021. On March 9, 2021, Protestants Camelot Transportation, Inc. and Triumph Transportation, Inc. filed a joint Motion for Leave to Withdraw their protests. Protestants' withdrawal from this matter renders the hearing unnecessary.

Based on the above, I find that the joint Motion for Leave to withdraw the protests of Camelot Transportation, Inc. and Triumph Transportation, Inc., should be granted, that the protests should
