By application filed May 18, 2020, Modest Movers, LLC d/b/a Middle West Movers ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No. M-14213 on November 21, 2011. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of household goods by straight truck within the Omaha, Nebraska, metro area only. Applicant also provided services as Black and White Moving Solution LLC d/b/a Middle West Movers. Applicant requested cancellation of its Certificate of authority due to the company no longer operating in the State of Nebraska.

Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 29, 2021. No protests were filed.
