By application filed February 19, 2021, James V. Meyer d/b/a Paradise Limo ("Applicant"), Blue Hill, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No. B-1675 on May 12, 2006. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers in limousine service between points in Webster, Adams, Clay, and Nuckols counties, and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points 200 miles east of Webster County over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and transportation must originate in Webster, Adams, Clay, or Nuckols counties. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 23, 2021. No protests were filed.

Applicant requested cancellation of its Certificate of authority due to the company having sold its assets and no longer operating in the State of Nebraska.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to James V. Meyer d/b/a Paradise Limo, Blue Hill, be, and is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Docket No. B-1675 is hereby cancelled.
