By application filed March 16, 2021, FunFamily Party Bus, LLC, ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No. B-1968 on May 30, 2018. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter between points in Douglas, Dodge, Lancaster, Sarpy, and Saunders counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews is not allowed and HHS Designation is no. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 22, 2021. No protests were filed.

In its Application, Applicant states that it is no longer in business. Therefore, the certificate of authority is no longer necessary.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted, and the authority granted to FunFamily Party Bus, LLC, Omaha, in Docket No. B-1968 should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of FunFamily Party Bus, LLC, Omaha, be, and is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Docket No. B-1968 is hereby cancelled.
