#### OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a Nebraska corporation with its principal place of business address in Omaha, Nebraska. Applicant was granted authority under Application No. B-2022 to transport passengers by sedan and van in open class service between points in Douglas and

Sarpy counties, and between said counties, over irregular routes. HHS designation is yes.

Applicant is seeking to establish its initial published rates for use in its operations. A review of Applicant's proposed rates in comparison to rates offered by similar carriers for similar services finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted.
