BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed March 2, 2021, FADI, LLC ("Applicant"), Bennington, seeks authority to operate as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

Transportation of passengers by sedan and van in open class service between points in Douglas, Dodge, Sarpy, Washington, and Cass counties, and between said counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: HHS Designation: No.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 10, 2025. Because no protests were filed, Application No. B-2025 was processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a Nebraska limited liability company with its principal business office in Bennington, Nebraska. Applicant proposes to provide transportation services as an open class carrier in and between Douglas, Dodge, Sarpy, Washington, and Cass counties. Applicant is not authorized to provided non-emergency medical transportation for the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. Applicant will provide its services with one vehicle.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service, and to conform to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-301 to 75-322 (Cum Supp. 2020) and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
- 2. The proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the following extent:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passengers by sedan and van in open class service between points in Douglas, Dodge, Sarpy, Washington, and Cass counties, and between said counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: none. HHS Designation: No.

3. The application for authority should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-2025 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to FADI, LLC, Bennington, Nebraska in Application No. B-2025, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until Applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Cum Supp. 2020), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to Applicant, be of no further force and effect.
