BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 8, 2021, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") Transportation Department filed a complaint against Safe Ride Shuttle ("Applicant"), Nebraska City, and other Respondents alleging violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305 (Cum. Supp. 2020) due to failure to timely file annual fees by March 1, 2021.¹ Safe Ride Shuttle was ordered to appear at a show-cause hearing scheduled for May 4, 2021 regarding the complaint.

On April 28, 2021, Applicant filed an application to cancel its certification of authority. Notice of this Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 3, 2021. No representative appeared at the May 4, 2021 show-cause hearing.

The Commission entered an Order on June 8, 2021 in Docket No. MCC-3196.03, finding that Safe Ride Shuttle should be dismissed from the complaint and that the cancelation of the certificate would be handled in a separate Order. Therefore, this Order shall serve to memorialize that finding.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Safe Ride Shuttle seeks to cancel the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No.

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B-1839 on September 24, 2013. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by van within the city limits of Nebraska City. Applicant only provided service on Friday and Saturday between 8:00 p.m. and 2:00 a.m. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage was not authorized and HHS designation was no.

Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-315 provides that a certificate or permit may be suspended, changed, or revoked by application of the certificate or permit holder or on the Commission's own motion after a hearing is properly noticed and held. Testimony by Commission staff at the May 4, 2021 hearing illustrated that Applicant no longer provided services in Nebraska, rendering the certificate of authority unnecessary. Additionally, Applicant stated in its revocation application that the company was no longer providing services in Nebraska.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted, and the authority granted to Safe Ride Shuttle, Nebraska City, in Docket No. B-1839 should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of Safe Ride Shuttle, Nebraska City, be, and is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Docket No. B-1839 is hereby cancelled.
