BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), on its own motion, is seeking to require Royal Limousine, Inc. ("Royal Limousine"), Omaha, to show cause as to why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Docket No. B-1618 should not be revoked.

Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305(1) requires all regulated motor carriers to pay an annual fee not exceeding eighty dollars (\$80) for each motor vehicle operated. Annual fees are due and payable to the Commission on or before January 1 and are delinquent March $1.^1$ Royal Limousine failed to pay its annual renewal fee as required by § 75-305(1) and was therefore named a Respondent in a Departmental Complaint opened on March 2, $2021.^2$

Commission staff spoke with Royal Limousine about its outstanding compliance steps. However, no representative of Royal Limousine appeared at the May 4, 2021 hearing. On June 8, 2021, the Commission entered an Order assessing a civil penalty of

three-thousand eight-hundred dollars (\$3,800).³ Further, the Commission gave Royal Limousine thirty (30) days from the mailing of the Order to pay the penalty or the matter could be referred to the Nebraska Attorney General's Office for collection through the District Court of Lancaster County and Royal Limousine could face further Commission action.⁴ To date, no action has been taken by Royal within the ordered timeframe.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that Royal Limousine, Inc. should be ordered to show cause as to why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to timely remit annual renewal fees in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305(1) and failure to comply with the Commission's June 8, 2021 Order. The Commission also finds that hearing on this matter should be held on Wednesday, August 25, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska. Remote access to the hearing will be available via WebEx at the following link: https://psc.nebraska.gov/stream. Individuals may also attend the meeting by telephone: dial 408-418-9388, then enter 146 273 5624 when prompted for the access code.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Royal Limousine, Inc., Omaha, be, and is hereby, ordered to show cause as to why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearing on this matter shall be scheduled for Wednesday, August 25, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. as provided herein.
