BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 27, 2021, Prestige Experiences, LLC ("Applicant"), Lincoln, seeks authority to operate as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

COMMON: Transportation of passengers by bus in special party service over regular routes in Lancaster County and between points in Lancaster, Hall, and Buffalo counties, and between said counties over irregular routes. HHS Designation: No.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 16, 2021. Because no protests were filed, Application No. B-2032 was processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a Nebraska Limited Liability Company with its principal business address in Lincoln, Nebraska. Applicant will provide bus service under special party classification over irregular routes and will also provide service via a regular route that begins in Lincoln with stops in Denton, Sprague, Hickman, and returning to Lincoln. Applicant plans to operate one vehicle at the outset of its operations.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service, and to conform to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-301 to 75-322 (Cum. Supp. 2020) and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
2. The proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the following extent:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passengers by bus in special party service over regular routes in Lancaster County and between points in Lancaster, Hall, and Buffalo counties, and between said counties over irregular routes. HHS Designation: No.

3. The application for authority should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-2032 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to Prestige Experiences, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska, in Application No. B-2032, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until Applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to Applicant, be of no further force and effect.
