BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed March 30, 2021, CareOne Transport Systems, LLC d/b/a CareOne ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeks authority to operate as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

COMMON: Transportation of passengers by van and sedan in open class service between points in Douglas, Dodge, Sarpy, Washington, Lancaster, Lincoln, Adams, Otoe, Hall, and Cass counties, and between said counties, over irregular routes. HHS Designation: Yes.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 2, 2021. Because no protests were filed, Application No. B-2029 was processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a Nebraska Limited Liability Company with its principle business address in Omaha, Nebraska. Applicant will provide transportation by van and sedan in open class service within and between a limited territory in the eastern part of the State. Applicant plans to operate one vehicle at the outset of its operations.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service, and to conform to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-301 to 75-322 (Cum. Supp. 2020) and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
2. The proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the following extent:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passengers by van and sedan in open class service between points in Douglas, Dodge, Sarpy, Washington, Lancaster, Lincoln, Adams, Otoe, Hall, and Cass counties, and between said counties, over irregular routes.

HHS Designation: Yes.

3. The application for authority should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-2029 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to CareOne Transport Systems, LLC d/b/a CareOne, Omaha, Nebraska in Application B-2029, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until Applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to Applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not conduct operations until a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is issued.
