O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305(2), the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") must annually determine the fee to be paid by Transportation Network Companies ("TNCs"). The annual fee is either twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or an amount not to exceed eighty dollars (\$80) for each personal vehicle operated by a driver of the TNC. The annual fee is currently set at \$25,000 or \$80 per vehicle. The Commission must determine the per-vehicle fee for 2022.

The Commission, therefore, finds that public hearing on this matter should be scheduled for **Tuesday, September 14, 2021 at 11:00 a.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska.
