O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed July 8, 2021, Mike's Capital Cab, LLC ("Applicant"), Lincoln, Nebraska, requests a suspension of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Application B-1901 until July 1, 2022. Applicant is authorized to provide, with restrictions, transportation of passengers by taxicab between points in Lincoln and a twenty-five-mile radius and between points in said area on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 14, 2021.

In its application, Applicant states that it is not able to provide its usual transportation services due to health issues experienced by ownership. As a result, Applicant requests that its Certificate be suspended.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Docket No. B-1999 should be suspended until July 1, 2022. Mike's Capital Cab must come into compliance with all Commission requirements either on or before the end of the suspension period or file a request to extend the suspension period. Failure to do so may result in Commission action.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request of Mike's Capital Cab, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska, to suspend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Docket No. B-1999 be, and is hereby, granted, and Certificate B-1999 is suspended until July 1, 2022.
