On July 5, 2019, a Formal Complaint was filed with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") by Ms. Cynthia Taylor ("Complainant"), Omaha, against Golden Plains Services, Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation ("GPS" or "Respondent"), Lincoln. On July 29, 2019, GPS filed its response to the complaint.

On March 5, 2021, Respondent filed a Motion to Dismiss the complaint. On or around July 19, 2021, the Commission sent Complainant a copy of the Motion and a letter stating Complainant was required to file written response to the Motion. A written response to Respondent's Motion was never received.

Both parties will be subject to questions from the Commission. Should either party decide to retain an attorney, the Commission must be notified, and the Attorney must file an entry of appearance prior to the oral argument.
