BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 13, 2021, CaPeace, Inc., d/b/a Commuter Express ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application for authority to amend its rates by eliminating all previously granted rates and replacing those rates as follows:

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OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a Nebraska corporation with its principal business address in Omaha, Nebraska. Applicant is a certificated carrier that holds Certificate B-1800 and authorized to transport passengers in open class by passenger van between points in Douglas and Sarpy counties and between points in the cities of Blair and Fort Calhoun and a three mile radius of said cities, and between points in said locations, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Douglas and Sarpy counties, including the transportation of clients of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services ("DHHS"), services under contract with DHHS, and other similar state and federal agencies. Applicant is further authorized to provide transportation of passengers and their baggage in open class service between points in the cities of Plattsmouth and Nebraska City and a three-mile radius of said cities, and between points in said locations, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Douglas and Sarpy counties over irregular routes, to include the transportation of DHHS clients and their subcontractors thereof. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation is yes.

On September 14, 2021, the Commission entered an Order finding that differential and discounted rates not enumerated under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-126 must be eliminated from the published rates of certificated carriers. Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-126 states that a common carrier shall not charge, demand, collect, or receive more or less compensation for any services rendered than what it charges, demands, collects, or receives from anyone for rendering the same services. The statute allows carriers to perform services for free or at a reduced rate for the following groups:

- (a) The United States, the State of Nebraska, or any governmental subdivision;
- (b) The employees, both present and retired, of the common carrier;
- (c) Any person when the object is to provide disaster relief;
- (d) Any person who transports property for charitable purposes;
- (e) Ministers and others giving their entire time to religious or charitable work;

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(f) Any person who is legally blind or visually handicapped.

Applicant is seeking to amend its existing rates previously granted under Rate Docket BR-397.² Applicant currently provides a discount program to senior citizens, members of the United States Military, as well as providing promotional coupons to the general public at the company's discretion. Such a discount program is not allowed under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-126. Applicant does not propose any additional changes to its existing rates. A review of Applicant's proposed rates in comparison to rates offered by similar carriers for similar services finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

Pursuant to the Commission's September 14, 2021 Order, applications filed prior to October 14, 2021, by certificated carriers seeking to amend their published rates to eliminate a differential or discounted rate will be considered on an emergency basis to facilitate a carrier's ability to quickly utilize the new rates. Applicant filed its application prior to the deadline. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective October 19, 2021.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that CaPeace, Inc., d/b/a Commuter Express, Omaha, Nebraska, be, and is hereby, authorized to amend its rates for its services effective October 19, 2021 as follows:
