#### BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 13, 2021, Nebraska Metro Transportation, LLC d/b/a Metro Sedan & Limousine Services ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application for authority to amend its rates by eliminating all discounted rates from its previously granted rates and to amend its remaining rates.

#### OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a Nebraska Limited Liability Company with its principal business address in Omaha, Nebraska. Applicant is a certificated carrier that holds Certificate B-1861 and is authorized to provide transportation to passengers by limousine within and between several Nebraska counties over irregular routes. HHS Designation is no.

On September 14, 2021, the Commission entered an Order finding that differential and discounted rates not enumerated under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-126 must be eliminated from the published rates of certificated carriers. Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-126 states that a common carrier shall not charge, demand, collect, or receive more or less compensation for any services rendered than what it charges, demands, collects, or receives from anyone for rendering the same services. The statute allows carriers to perform services for free or at a reduced rate for the following groups:

(a) The United States, the State of Nebraska, or any governmental subdivision;

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- (b) The employees, both present and retired, of the common carrier;
- (c) Any person when the object is to provide disaster relief;
- (d) Any person who transports property for charitable purposes;
- (e) Ministers and others giving their entire time to religious or charitable work;
- (f) Any person who is legally blind or visually handicapped.

Applicant is seeking to amend its existing rates most recently granted under Rate Docket BR-500.<sup>2</sup> Applicant currently provides discounted rates for family, friends, and military. Such discounts are not allowed under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-126. Applicant also proposes changes to its existing rates by incorporating transfer point-based rates and eliminating rates for buses and stretch limousines. Applicant is also adding the ground transportation fee assessed for all pick-ups and drop-offs at Omaha Eppley Airfield. A review of Applicant's proposed rates in comparison to rates offered by similar carriers for similar services finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

Pursuant to the Commission's September 14, 2021 Order, applications filed prior to October 14, 2021, by certificated carriers seeking to amend their published rates to eliminate a differential or discounted rate will be considered on an emergency basis to facilitate a carrier's ability to quickly utilize the new rates. Applicant filed its application prior to the deadline. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective October 19, 2021.

#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Nebraska Metro Transportation d/b/a Metro Sedan & Limousine Services, Omaha, Nebraska, be, and is hereby, authorized
