BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

By application filed October 4, 2019, LaToya Prince Ventures, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeks authority as a contract carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to a contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. HHS Designation is yes.

Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 19, 2020. Timely protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Happy Cab and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Checker Cab Company and zTrip; WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and zTrip; and WHC NE, LLC d/b/a Safeway Cabs and zTrip (collectively "Protestants"). Protests were granted on October 1, 2020.

On October 22, 2020, the Hearing Officer entered an Order scheduling a planning conference to determine a procedural schedule and set a hearing date. It was later determined that the

planning conference needed to be rescheduled. On September 28, 2021, the Commission entered an order of Pending Dismissal requiring Applicant to contact the Commission about its application no later than October 22, 2021. To date, Applicant has not taken any action on the application.

After due consideration and being fully advised on the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Application No. B-2004 should be dismissed.

## O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission Application B-2004 be, and is hereby, dismissed.
