## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On September 14, 2021, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") received a Form K Insurance Cancellation Notice for Extreme Nightlife, LLC ("Extreme Nightlife"), Lincoln, who holds a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity under Certificate No. B-2004. The Form K received from Columbia Insurance Company had a cancellation date of October 13, 2021.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 006, all carriers are required to file documents with the Commission that show proof of current insurance that meets the minimum insurance requirements. Extreme Nightlife was notified by letter of the cancellation notice but did not respond to the letter or any department outreach. To date, the Commission has not received a current Form E Insurance filing and the department has notified the carrier to cease and desist any operations.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that Extreme Nightlife, LLC, Lincoln, should be ordered to show cause as to why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be suspended, modified, or revoked in whole or in part, for failure to maintain required liability insurance and provide proof of such insurance to the Commission in accordance with Commission Rule 006. Therefore, hearing on this matter shall be held on Tuesday, November 30, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska. ## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Extreme Nightlife, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska, be, and is hereby, ordered to show cause as to why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to maintain current liability insurance in accordance with Commission Rule 006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearing on this matter shall be set for **Tuesday**, **November 30**, **2021 at 10:30 a.m.** as provided herein.
