On September 9, 2021, Families and Connections Transporting Services, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application seeking authority as a contract carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers in open class service within Douglas and Sarpy counties, and between said counties, over irregular routes pursuant to a contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, a Medicaid-managed care organization under contract with NDHHS, or another agent working on behalf of NDHHS. HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 7, 2021. On December 21, 2021, timely protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc. and Triumph Transportation, Inc.
