#### BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On March 8, 2021, Justin Sanango d/b/a Just In Time Medical Transportation ("Applicant"), Lincoln, Nebraska, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van in open class service between points in Lancaster, Douglas, York, Seward, and Hall counties, and between said counties, over irregular routes.
