BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 4, 2022, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered an order in the above-captioned docket to order several named carriers to appear before the Commission to show cause as to why their certificates or permits of authority should not be suspended for failure to remit annual fees in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305 (Cum. Supp. 2020).<sup>1</sup> Hearing on this matter is scheduled for January 25, 2022.

The following carriers remitted the required annual renewal forms, annual renewal payments, and proof of current insurance to the Commission:

Night Life Limousine, LLC  
Yellow Cab Beatrice d/b/a Leisure Taxi

These carriers have complied with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305 (Cum. Supp. 2020) by making the requisite payments and filing the necessary documentation. As such, staff recommends the above-mentioned carriers be dismissed from the docket. Furthermore, the carriers are on notice that failure to remit future annual renewal forms, fees, and proof of insurance prior to the January 1 deadline could result in suspension of their certificate or permit of authority.

During the 2021 annual renewal period, Cornbelt Development d/b/a Travel Plus Limousines informed staff that the company owner had passed away. The company was instructed it had a year to transfer authority pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-321, otherwise the authority would be automatically revoked. No transfer application was received, and the Certificate of Authority held by Cornbelt Development d/b/a Travel Plus Limousines was therefore

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revoked. As this carrier's authority was revoked, the Commission finds that Cornbelt Development d/b/a Travel Plus Limousines should be dismissed from the docket and excused from appearing at the show cause hearing scheduled for January 25, 2022.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that Night Life Limousine, LLC, Yellow Cab Beatrice d/b/a Leisure Taxi, and Cornbelt Development d/b/a Travel Plus Limousines, should be dismissed from this docket.

## O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Night Life Limousine, LLC, Yellow Cab Beatrice d/b/a Leisure Taxi, and Cornbelt Development d/b/a Travel Plus Limousines, be, and are hereby, dismissed.
