BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 4, 2022, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered an order in the above-captioned docket to order several named carriers to appear before the Commission to show cause as to why their certificates or permits of authority should not be suspended for failure to remit annual fees in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305 (Cum. Supp. 2020).<sup>1</sup> Hearing on this matter was held January 25, 2022.

On February 1, 2022, the Commission entered an Order to dismiss carriers, in part, and sustain action against the remaining carriers to the show-cause docket. In its Order, the Commission suspended the authorities of several named carriers and ordered these carriers to cease and desist all transportation services until such time as the named carriers completed their annual renewal requirements and the Commission entered an order to reauthorize the provision of services.<sup>2</sup>

After the Order was entered, First Student, Inc., remitted its required annual renewal fee, vehicle list, and proof of current insurance to the Commission. Commission staff recommends that First Student, Inc., be dismissed from this docket, removed from suspension, and its transportation services be reauthorized.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that First Student, Inc., should be dismissed from this docket. The Commission also finds that the suspension and cease and desist be removed and First Student, Inc., may resume providing services. First Student, Inc. is on notice that failure to remit future annual renewal forms,
