BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 17, 2021, Shiloh Center, LLC ("Applicant"), Fremont, Nebraska, seeks authority to operate as a contract carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

CONTRACT: Transportation of passengers by van in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to service contracts with Shiloh Place, LLC, and Shiloh Center Adult Day Services. RESTRICTIONS: Limited to residents of Shiloh Place Assisted Living and participants/clients of Shiloh Center Adult Day Services. HHS Designation: Yes - limited to clients transported pursuant to a contract.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on December 7, 2021. Because no protests were filed, Application No. B-2047 was processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

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O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a Nebraska Limited Liability Company with its principal place of business in Fremont, Nebraska. Applicant will provide transportation by van between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to contracts with Shiloh Place, LLC, and Shiloh Center Adult Day Services. Applicant's services are limited to residents of Shiloh Place Assisted Living and participants/clients of Shiloh Center Adult Day Services. Applicant will begin providing services with two vehicles.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. The proposed contract carrier operation is consistent with the public interest.
2. The application should be granted to the following extent:

PERMIT AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

CONTRACT: Transportation of passengers by van in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to service contracts with Shiloh Place, LLC and Shiloh Center Adult Day Services. RESTRICTIONS: Limited to residents of Shiloh Place Assisted Living and participants/clients of Shiloh Center Adult Day Services. HHS Designation: Yes - limited to clients transported pursuant to a contract.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-2047 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Permit of Authority shall be issued to Shiloh Center, LLC, Fremont, Nebraska, in Application B-2047, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until Applicant has fully complied, within 45 days from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat.

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§§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Cum. Supp 2020), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to Applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not conduct operations until a Permit of Authority is issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
